- besplatan i stalan pristup punom tekstu naučnih članaka
- neograničena distribucija i korišćenje članaka od svih korisnika
- istraživači u celosti zadržavaju autorska prava nad svojim radovima
- recenzirani časopisi (članci), disertacije, kongresna sopštenja

Otvoreni pristup

Članci moraju biti deponovani u javnoj i dostupnoj arhivi:

- u IR svoje institucije, ili
- predmetno orijentisanoj arhivi (arXiv, PubMed Central, SCIELO), ili
- OA časopisu (ko plaća nadoknadu), ili
- nacionalnom repozitoriju (Cream of Science)

Promena ekonomskog modela

Ko plaća izdavanje časopisa i koliko:


- BMC oko 600\$, PLoS oko 1500\$
- veliki svetski izdavači (Springer, IoP) do 3000\$
- institucionalna članarina

Činjenice

- 239 časopisa na ISI listi (naši: JSCS, SS)
- 14 u prvih 10% u svojoj disciplini
- PLoS Biology vodeći u grupi opšte biologije posle samo dve godine izlaženja (IF=13.99)
- članci objavljeni u ovom režimu citiraniji su od ostalih

- formiranje harvester-a OAI data provider-a
- DOAJ lista ravnopravna sa ostalim u Elečasu
- preuzimaju se još dve liste (imena)
- objavljivanje naših autora u OA časopisima

Ko sve dobija otvorenim pristupom?

1. istraživači u sve tri uloge :

- **autori**: OA povećava vidljivost njihovih nalaza, a time i citiranost/uticajnost
- **korisnici**: OA obezbeđuje veći broj članaka za istraživačke potrebe
- **nastavnici**: OA znači neograničeni pristup člancima za korišćenje u nastavi (više u svetu)

Ko sve dobija otvorenim pristupom?

2. **univerziteti/instituti**: profitiraju na povećanju vidljivosti i uticajnosti svojih nastavnika
3. **finansijeri istraživanja**: vlade i agencije dobijaju najveću moguću vidljivost i uticajnost svojih ulaganja
4. **izdavači**: povećanje impakta na osnovu veće dostupnosti

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
